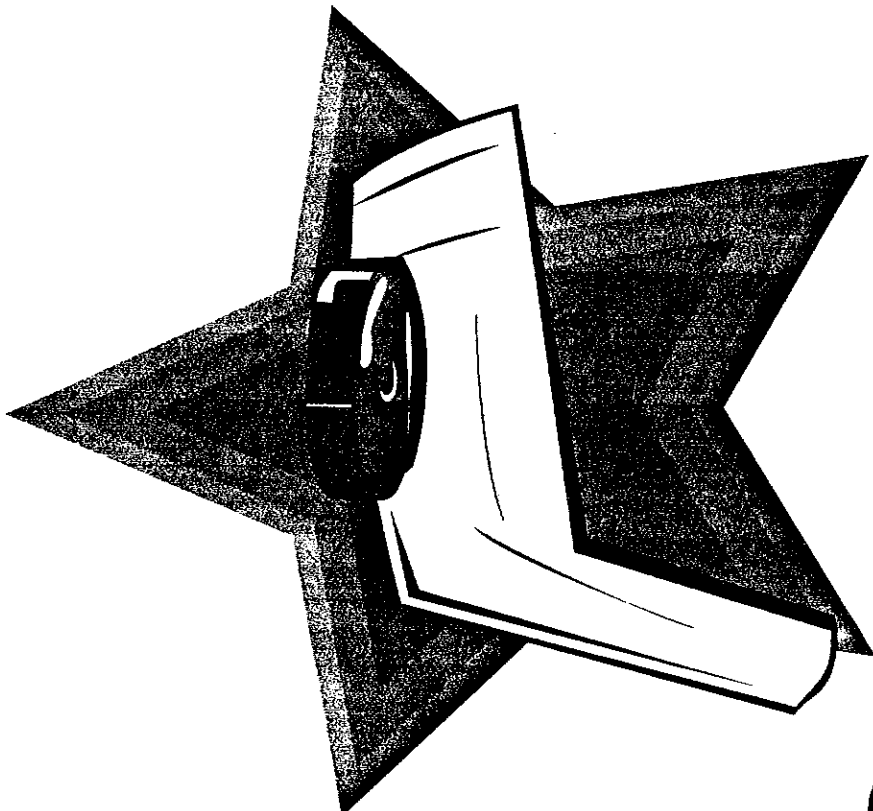

COACH: Mike Arcalae

Organization of warm-up and practice drills. Provide individuals assistance's as well as provide encouragement to team members. Warm-up sheets and drill sheets will be provided for each team. It is the coaches' responsibility to pick up the sheets and get their team to work.

EQUIPMENT MANAGER: Scott David

In charge of disturbing, collecting, and returning all equipment at the beginning, during, and at the end of class. It is the equipment manager's responsibility to report any damaged equipment. They also make sure all equipment is stored safety in an organized fashion off the playing field.

ATHLETIC TRAINER: Shawn Sesock

The trainer's job is to stretch and have his or her team ready to go before each drill or game is introduced. They must also report all injuries to the teacher and retrieve ice when needed. They also make sure everyone on their team is properly stretched and ready to play each day.
